SEC. 18. The office of District Attorney, created by the Act entitled "an Act Creating the Office of District Attorney in each of the organized Judicial Districts of Idaho Territory, and defining their duties, privileges and powers, and fixing their compensation," Approved, January 11th, A. D., 1866, is hereby declared abolished at the expiration of the term of office of the several District Attorneys elected at the last General Election.

SEC. 19. This Act shall take effect from and after its passage.

CHAPTER X. AN ACT

Amendatory of an Act entitled "An Act Concerning Crimes and Punishments." Approved, December 21st, A. D., 1864.

Be it enacted by the Legislative Assembly of the Territory of Idaho, as follows :

SECTION 1. That Section 118 of said Act be amended so as to read as follows: If any person shall wilfully or maliciously disturb the peace or quiet of any neighborhood or family by loud or unusual noises, or by tumultuous or offensive conduct, threatening, traducing, quarreling, challenging to fight, or fighting, or by the firing any gun, pistol, or any other species of fire arms within the limits of any city, town or village in this Territory, every person convicted thereof shall be fined in a sum not exceeding two hundred dollars, or imprisonment in the County Jail, not exceeding two months.

SEC. 2. This Act to take effect and be in force from and after the first day of February, A. D., 1869.
