| <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Streets, &c., not to be dug up, nor stagings erected, nor stone, &c., deposited thereon, without license; licenses to state space and time of occupation. 2. When streets, &c., are so dug up, &c., under license, railings or fence to be put up, and lights kept around places obstructed, &c.; streets, &c., thereafter to be repaired, &c. 3. Awnings, &c., not to be maintained over streets, &c., unless, &c.; nor without permission of mayor, &c., permission revocable, &c. 4. Signs, flags, merchandise, &c., not to be suspended, &c., on or over sidewalks, &c., unless, &c., nor without permission of mayor, &c., permission revocable, &c. 5. House dirt, ashes, filth, shells or other rubbish, not to be placed in streets, &c. 6. Fire-wood, coal and other fuel, not to remain on sidewalks, &c., over night or after twilight, unnecessarily; if necessarily left, lights to be kept, &c. 7. Sheep and other cattle, not to be at large or depastured in streets, &c. | <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 8. Driving horses in streets faster than eight miles per hour, &c., prohibited. 9. Vehicles, for conveyance of articles for hire, not to stand for orders on streets, &c., except at stands assigned by mayor and aldermen; mayor and aldermen may grant licenses for employment of such vehicles, and designate stands therefor. Licenses revocable for violation of provisions of this section, &c. 10. Vehicles, for conveyance of persons for hire, not to stand for orders on streets, &c., except at stands assigned, except, &c.; city marshal to assign stands for. Licenses may be revoked for violation of provisions of this section. 11. Vehicles, for selling goods, &c., not to stand where; may stand where; with wood, person in charge must have certificate of quantity, &c. 12. Vehicles, of burden or pleasure, not to be driven, &c., on sidewalks, except for crossing; children's carriages drawn by hand excepted. 13. Teams, not to stand across public highways, &c., nor stop beside another so as to |

streets, &c., public place, or on any square or sidewalk, in the city prohibited. for the sale of fruit or other things.

Firearms, not to be discharged in streets, &c., except &c. SECT. 21. No person shall discharge any gun, pistol or other firearm in any of the streets, highways, public squares or commons in the city; *provided*, this section shall not apply to the use of such weapons in the lawful defense of the person, family or property of any one, or in the performance of any duty required by law, nor to the firing of a salute of cannon or artillery by permission of the mayor and aldermen.

Fireworks, bonfires, &c., setting fire to without license, prohibited. SECT. 22. No person shall set fire to any rocket, cracker, squib, serpent or other fireworks, or make any bonfire in any street, lane, highway, public square or common in the city, without a license from the mayor and aldermen.

Fences, &c., not to be marred, &c. SECT. 23. No person shall wantonly mar, injure, deface or destroy any fence, guide-post, sign-board, awning, lamp-post, lamp or lantern, in any street, square or public place in the city.

City lamps, not to be lighted or extinguished without permission. SECT. 24. No person shall light or extinguish any city lamp in any street, square or public place in the city, except by permission of the mayor and aldermen.

Trees, not to be cut down, &c., without permission; animals not to be fastened to. SECT. 25. No person shall cut down, remove, injure or destroy any fruit, shade or other tree, growing or being in any public street, lane, alley, common or other public ground in the city, without the permission of the mayor and aldermen. And no person shall fasten any horse or other animal to any such tree.

Street dirt, &c., restriction as to removal of. SECT. 26. No person shall remove any street dirt or manure from any public street, lane or alley in the city, without authority from the superintendent of streets.

Disorderly conduct, indecent or profane language, in streets forbidden. SECT. 27. No person shall behave himself in a rude and disorderly manner, or use any indecent or profane language in any street, lane, alley or other public place in the city.

Indecent exposure in bathing, &c., prohibited. SECT. 28. No person shall swim or bathe in any pond, stream or river in the city, divested of clothing so as to be indecently exposed to the view of any person lawfully passing or being in or upon any street, lane,
