person who shall do any of the acts prohibited by this section, shall forfeit and pay for each offense, a sum not to exceed ^{Penalty.} twenty-five dollars for the use of said borough.

SEC. 15. The erecting or placing any building, gate, fence, ^{Placing any gate, fence, box, wood, brick, etc., on any street.} post, box, cask, wood, brick, stone, vehicle not attached to any animal, or other thing in, upon, or across any street, sidewalk or highway; the placing, hanging or maintaining of any sign, ^{Hanging sign, awning, etc., across street.} article of merchandise, awning, or other thing whatsoever, above, over, or across, any street or sidewalk when prohibited by the court of burgesses; the discharging any pistol, gun, ^{Discharging fire-arms.} cannon or other fire-arms, by any person or military company in any street, park or public ground, provided this section does not apply to the use of such weapons in lawful defence of the person, family or property of any one, or in the performance of any duty required by law; the blasting of rocks by gunpowder ^{Explosives.} or other explosive substances; opening or making any excava- ^{Excavations.} tion, vault, or cellar in, upon or under any street or highway; posting any bills, placards, notices or advertisements, or the post- ^{Posting bills, etc., on public buildings or in streets.} ing of any notice whatever upon any building or other structure whatsoever belonging to the borough, or upon any sidewalk or elsewhere within the public streets, or kindling any bon-fire, or ^{Bonfires.} fire in any public street, without the consent of the warden or court of burgesses, are hereby prohibited; and every person who shall, without such consent of said warden or court of burgesses first had or obtained, do any of the acts prohibited in this section, shall forfeit and pay for each offence a sum not ^{Penalty.} exceeding twenty-five dollars for the use of the borough, provided, however, that nothing in this section contained shall be construed to prevent or hinder any person while in the process of building, or repairing dwelling-houses or other buildings, from placing in any street or highway material for such pur- ^{Building materials may be left in street when—} poses, with the consent of, and under such conditions and distinctions as may be prescribed in each particular case by the warden or court of burgesses in a permit in writing.

SEC. 16. Every person who shall set fire to, or discharge, any ^{Fire-works.} fire-crackers, rockets or other fire-works in said borough during any period of time when the same shall be prohibited by the court of burgesses, or who shall sell, keep or expose for sale within said borough during such period as shall be prohibited
