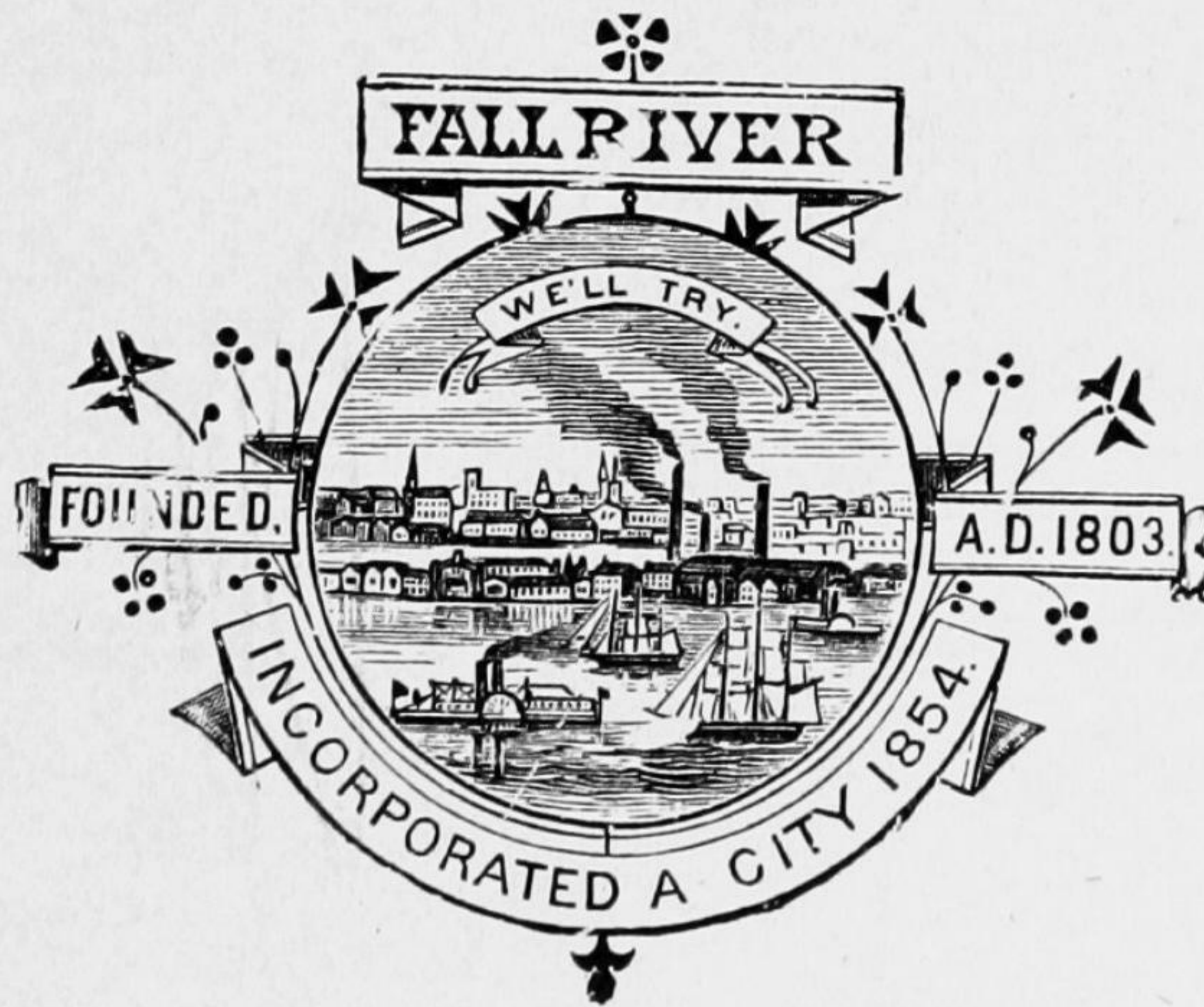

barrel, package, article or deposit of any kind, so as to interfere with the convenient use thereof by the travelers.

Contents of  
privy vaults.

SECT. 16. No person shall drive, have or use upon any street or public place any cart or vehicle containing or used for removing the contents of privy vaults or cesspools, except in accordance with a license from the board of health.

Riding on back  
of carriages.

SECT. 17. No person shall take hold of or ride upon the back part of any sleigh, cart, carriage or vehicle while the same is passing through any street, without the permission of the owner or driver of the same.

Playing games.

SECT. 18. No person shall shoot with bow and arrow, or play at ball or other game, fly kite, throw stone or other missile in any street or public place.

Indecent writ-  
ings.

SECT. 19. No person shall make any indecent figures, or write indecent or obscene words upon any sidewalk, fence, building, post, tree or other object within or along any street or public place.

Discharge of  
firearms.

SECT. 20. No person shall, except in the performance of some legal duty, discharge any gun, pistol or firearm in any street or public place, or within fifty rods of any dwelling house.

Standing to-  
gether.

SECT. 21. No person shall stand with, or near to, two or more persons upon any sidewalk or public place so as to obstruct or inconvenience travel thereon.

Removal of  
snow from  
sidewalk.

SECT. 22. The owner, occupant or person having the care of any building or lot of land, bordering on any street or public place where there is a curbed sidewalk, shall cause all snow or slush to be removed from said sidewalk, when said sidewalk abuts the said building or land, within six hours after the snow ceases falling, if it ceases to fall in the daytime, and within six hours after sunrise if it ceases to fall in the night.

Removal of  
street dirt.

SECT. 23. No person shall remove any street dirt or manure from any street or public place without permission from the superintendent of streets.

Moving of  
buildings.

SECT. 24. No person shall move, or assist in moving, any building through or over any street unless in accordance with a license from the mayor and aldermen. The mayor and aldermen shall in all such cases require a bond, with sufficient sureties, conditioned to save the city harmless from all loss or damages by reason of the moving of the building. No such license shall be issued without public notice and opportunity for hearing.
