SEC. 2. No licensee or his employe, or other person in charge of any billiard table, pool table, bagatelle table, pigeon hole table, or shovel board, shall, at any time, with or without gain or profit, permit or allow any such table or board to be used by any minor, for any purpose whatever. Any person violating, failing, neglecting or refusing to comply with any provision, regulation or requirement of this section, shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor, and upon conviction thereof before the Superior Court, shall be fined not less than ten dollars nor more than one hundred dollars, and in addition thereto said Superior Court shall adjudge and declare such license forfeited to the City of Council Bluffs, and thereafter it shall be unlawful for such licensee or any other person to do business under such forfeited license.

City Clerk

SEC. 3. The City Clerk shall keep a book wherein he shall register the number of any and all such tables and boards that are licensed. Upon licensing a table or board, said City Clerk shall deliver to the licensee a metallic plate. The licensee shall securely fasten the same in some conspicuous place upon such licensed table or board, and keep the same so fastened during the time such license is in force, and upon the expiration or forfeiture of such license, said licensee shall return said metallic plate to said City Clerk.

Ten pin alleys

SEC. 4. No person shall keep or take part in keeping any pin alley or ball alley, for gain or profit, without license therefor from said city, and the charge for such license shall be twenty-five dollars per year.

## SHOOTING GALLERY.

Shooting galleries

SEC. 5. No person shall carry on or take part in carrying on any pistol gallery or shooting gallery without license therefor from said city, and the charge for such license shall be ten dollars per month, or fifty dollars per annum.

SEC. 6. No licensee or his employe, or any person in charge of any pin alley, ball alley, pistol gallery or shooting gallery, shall
