*First.* Menagerie and circus combined, one hundred and fifty dollars per day, and in case the tents are outside the city limits, no street parade shall be permitted unless regular license is paid.

*Second.* Menagerie or circus, or equestrian exhibition, one hundred dollars per day, and in case the tents are outside the city limits, no street parade shall be permitted unless regular license is paid.

*Third.* Any show, side show, street exhibition or amusement, ten dollars per day.

*Fourth.* For a theatre, museum, opera, lecture or concert, five dollars per day: *Provided*, that monthly or semi-annual licenses may be issued, (except to menageries, circuses or equestrian exhibitions), on the payment of forty dollars for one month, seventy-five dollars for three months.

*Fifth.* Minstrel performance, public ball, public masquerade, public pedestrian or wrestling exhibition, five dollars per day.

*Sixth.* Any public entertainment not previously mentioned, five dollars per day, or twenty-five dollars per month.

*Seventh.* No license shall be required for any entertainment given by the citizens of this city, when the same shall not be for gain or profit to the persons giving such entertainment.

SEC. 2. (§ 73.) *Ten pin alley; license for.*—No person shall keep or take part in keeping any ten pin alley or ball alley for gain or profit, without a license therefor from said city; and the charge for such license shall be fifteen dollars per year.

SEC. 3. (§ 74.) *Shooting gallery; license for.*—No person shall carry on or take part in carrying on, any pistol gallery or shooting gallery, without a license therefor from said city; and the charge for such license shall be five dollars per month.

SEC. 4. (§ 75.) *Horoscope views; license.*—No person shall keep horoscope views for gain or profit, without a license
