

ORDINANCES

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OF THE

CITY OF SAINT PAUL,

FROM

MAY, 1887, to JULY, 1889.

OFFICIALLY PUBLISHED BY THE CITY OF SAINT PAUL.

SAINT PAUL:
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shall engage in, conduct, manage or carry on either or any of the different and various kind of business, employment or avocation hereafter mentioned or specified in the city of St. Paul, without first having paid into the City Treasury of St. Paul the sum and amount of money for the particular and separate kind of business, employment or avocation as hereinafter fixed, established and stated therefor respectively. Any person, firm, association, corporation or other combination of persons who shall be proven guilty before any court having jurisdiction thereof, of being engaged in, conducting, managing or carrying on any of the hereinafter named kinds of business, employments or avocations, within the limits of the city of Saint Paul, without having a city license therefor, shall be fined by said court for first offence in any sum or amount not exceeding fifty (\$50) dollars, and for the second and every subsequent offense in any sum or amount not exceeding one hundred (\$100) dollars.

SECTION TWO.

The different and various kinds of business, employments and avocations for which licenses are hereby fixed and established, and the sum and amount of the license for each separate one are as follows, to wit:

Gun powder.....	\$15.00
Runners, hotel.....	10.00

SECTION THREE.

All applicants for a license hereinunder shall first pay into the City Treasury the amount above specified for the particular kind of business, employment or avocation he or they desire a license for, taking a receipt specifying for what the same was given and the amount paid therefor, and upon presenting
