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pose of disturbing or carrying away any box, gum or vessel containing bees or honey, shall be fined in any sum not exceeding one hundred (\$100) dollars, or imprisoned in the jail of the county not exceeding sixty (60) days, and shall make restitution to the party injured in double the amount of damages sustained.

SECTION 3. That Section 5666, of Chapter 11, of the Criminal Code of Nebraska, as the same appears in Cobbey's Consolidated Statutes of 1891, be amended to read as follows:

Section 5666. It shall also be unlawful for any person, at any time, by the aid or use of any swivel, punt gun, big gun (so called), or any other than the common shoulder gun; or by the aid or use of any punt boat, or sneak boat used for carrying such gun, to catch, kill, wound, or destroy, or to pursue after with intent to catch, kill, wound or destroy, upon any of the waters, bays, rivers, marshes, mud flats, or any cover to which wild fowl resort within the state of Nebraska, any wild goose, wood duck, teal, canvas-back, bluebill, or other wild duck, or to destroy or disturb the eggs of any of the birds above named; and any person offending against any of the provisions of this act shall be fined in any sum not less than two (\$2) dollars, nor more than twenty (\$20) dollars, for each offense, or be imprisoned in the county jail not more than twenty (20) days.
