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CHAPTER V.

AN ORDINANCE IN RELATION TO DRUNKENNESS.

SECTION 1. Every person who shall be found so drunken as to amount to a violation of decency upon the premises of any other person, or in any public hall, or at any public meeting, or in any street, alley, lane, or other public place within this town, shall pay a fine not exceeding twenty dollars, or be imprisoned not exceeding ten days.

CHAPTER VI.

AN ORDINANCE IN RELATION TO DISCHARGING FIRE-ARMS, PLAYING AT BALL AND OTHER GAMES IN THE STREETS AND HIGHWAYS.

SECTION 1. Every person who shall play at ball, or any other game or sport, throw stones or other missiles, discharge any gun, pistol, or other fire-arms, fire any torpedo, fire-cracker, or other noisy missile in any public place, street, or highway in this town, shall, on conviction thereof, pay a fine of not less than one dollar, nor more than five dollars, for every such offense.

CHAPTER VII.

AN ORDINANCE IN RELATION TO BATHING.

SECTION 1. Every person who shall openly and publicly bathe at any place in sight of and within one hundred and fifty rods of any public highway, place of resort, or dwelling house in this town, in the day-time, without being at the time properly and sufficiently clothed or dressed, or who shall make an indecent exposure of the person at such place or places, shall pay a fine of not less than two dollars, nor more than twenty dollars for every such offense, or be imprisoned not exceeding ten days.
