The provisions of this section shall extend to taxes collected for levee purposes, where land is improperly sold or taxes improperly collected, and the amount due in such case shall be paid to the proper person by the levee treasurer on the order of the levee board.

Chapter 10.

AN ACT to amend section 3761 of the annotated code of 1892, in reference to providing printed list furnished tax-payers, making national bank notes, legal tender notes, etc., liable for taxes.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Mississippi*, That section 3761 of the annotated code of 1892, be amended so as to read as follows: Section 3761. Printed list furnished tax-payers. The board of supervisors shall furnish the assessor with printed list as follows, viz: Tax list of election district——in supervisor's district number——in——county, and for cities, towns and villages as follows: Tax-list for the city, town or village of——in——county:
