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PARK ORDINANCES.

Penal Ordinances relating to the Use, Regulation, Protection and Government of the Mesier Park of the Village of Wappingers Falls. Passed August 23rd, 1892.

The Board of Park Commissioners of the Village of Wappingers Falls does ordain and determine as follows :

SECTION 1. No person or persons shall fire or discharge any gun or pistol or other firearm, or any rocket torpedo, or other fireworks of any description, nor send up any balloon, nor throw stones or missiles, nor play ball within the limits of the Mesier Park, without the permission first obtained of the Park Commissioners at a meeting of the Board.

§ 2. No person shall climb any tree, or pluck any flowers, whether wild or cultivated, nor break, cut down, trample upon or remove, or in any manner injure or deface any statue, ornament, tree, plant, shrub, flower, flower bed, turf or any of the buildings, fences, settees, or other constructions within said Park, nor remove any settee from its position, nor shall any person write upon any building, structure, bench, rock or stone within, or which is appurtenant to said Park.

§ 3. No horse or other animal used for riding or driving, or vehicle of any description will be allowed in any part of said Park, except upon the roads or other places appropriated for horses and carriages except with the consent of the Board of Park Commissioners.

§ 4. No cart, wagon, dray, truck, delivery wagon, or other vehicle carrying stone, brick, manure, soil, goods, merchandise, or other articles shall be allowed to enter or drive in the Park, nor to pass through the Park, except when carrying supplies to the duly authorized occupants of the Park buildings. This section, however, shall not apply to vehicles, loaded or unloaded, employed by the Park Com-
